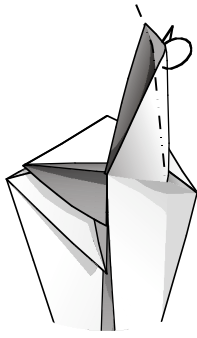
Dimension / R=0.5 - 0.8 for length (depending on pose)



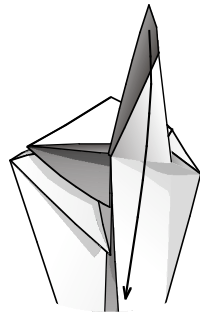
Author's advice: Use a bicolored square, red-brown on one side and black on the other. This model is a slight variation of the kit fox with some color changes.

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1. Start with black side up. Crease the diagonal and the midpoint of the left edge at point P.
2. Do these steps.
3. Swivel-fold the raw edge.
4. Omit step 18 of the Kit Fox.
5. Valley-fold and unfold the right top corner to an edge of the swivel fold.
6. Do these steps.
7. Lift up the leg.
8. Crimp the top layer of the leg to expose dark paper.
- Note:** The tip of the flap will not lie flat.

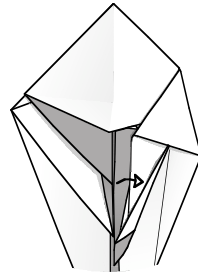




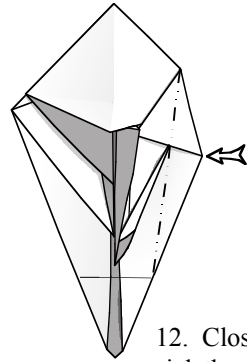
9. Wrap crimped paper to the other side.



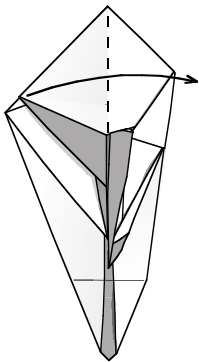
10. Fold the leg flap down.



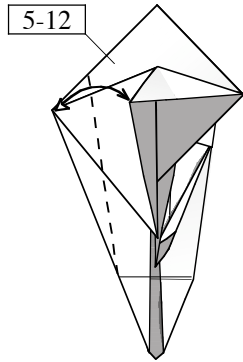
11. Put the swivel-folded dark paper on top of the leg.



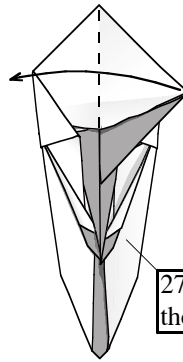
12. Close sink the edge.



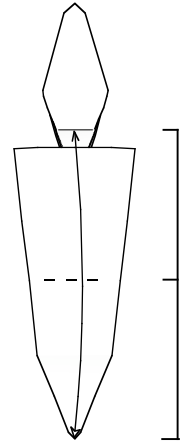
13. Valley-fold two flaps to the right



14. Repeat steps 5 to 12 on the left side.



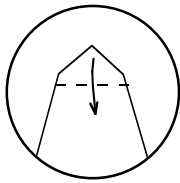
15. Do these steps.



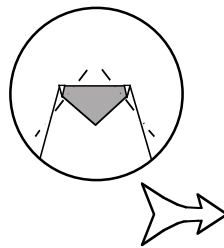
16. Bisect the distance from the bottom corner to a crease in the tail. Mark it with a crease.



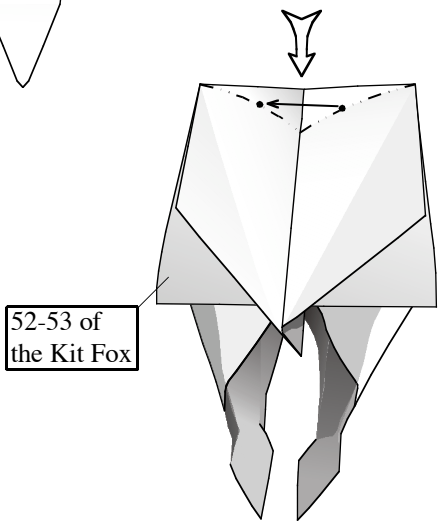
17. Valley-fold the tail tip down.



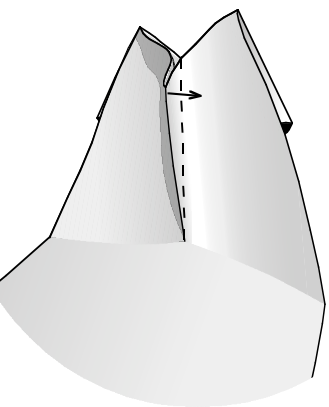
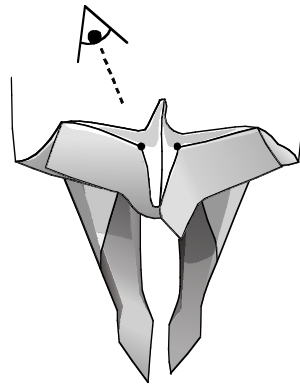
18. Round the tail tip with mountain folds.



19. Do these steps.

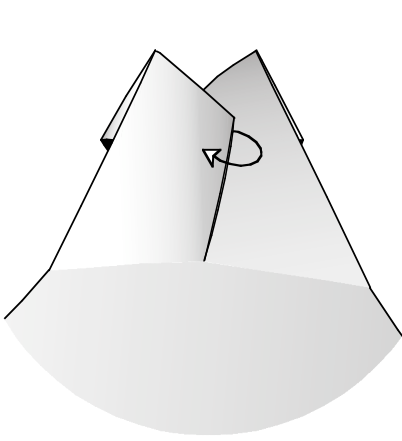


20. Bring the points marked by the dots together by sinking the paper between the ears.

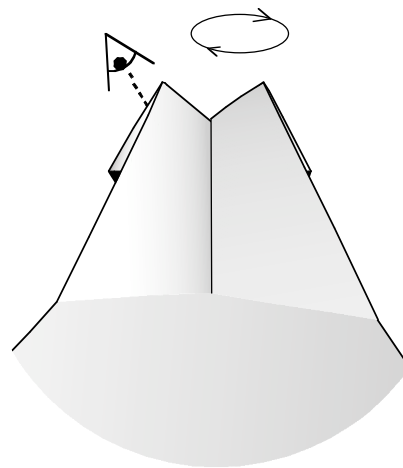


21. Valley-fold the flap on the neck to the right.

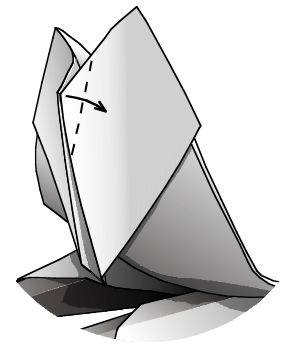




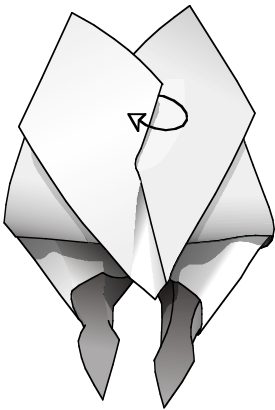
22. Put a layer on top of the flap. I do this by partially opening the sink.



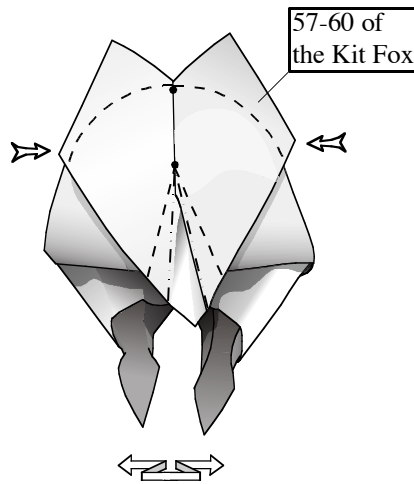
Next view is of the head.



23. Valley-fold the top of a flap to the right.



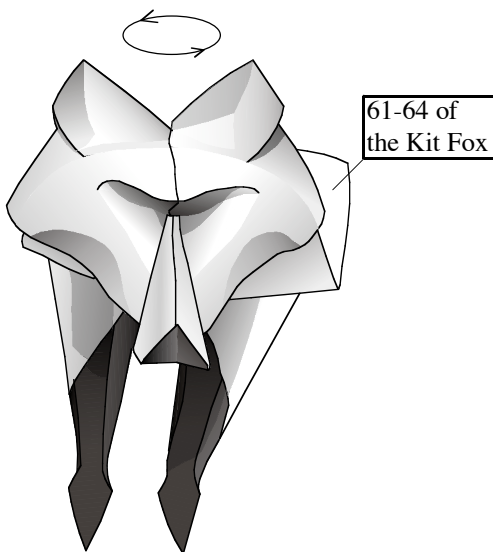
24. Put a layer on top of the flap.



25. Crimp the nose and shape the forehead without undoing the pleat between the dots.



26. Crimp the ears and cup them.



27. Rotate the fox to the side and shape the back legs, body, and tail.
