## Santa (naughty or nice?)

Created by Bernie Peyton /2009 Difficulty / Low Intermediate Time to Create / 20 minutes Dimension / $\mathrm{R}=0.7$ for height


Author's advice: Use a bi-colored square. Red and white is traditional, but any color combination will make a decorative santa. Kami works well.

3. Repeat the last step on the right side.

6. Valley-fold the left side to the center line.

7. Valley-fold and unfold both layers of the corner on the crease of step 2 .

10. Unfold the corner.

13. Repeat steps 6 to 9 on the right side.


First pull the corner to the right.

8. Inside reverse-fold corner.

11. Valley-fold the bottom edge to the intersection marked by the dot.

14. Valley-fold and unfold an angle bisector.


Part of the arm will buckle toward you. Valley-fold this section up.

9. Valley-fold and unfold both corner layers along the indicated edge.

12. Valley-fold the bottom edge back down where the sides of the reverse fold of step 8 meet.

15. Swivel the corner to the right on the hidden valley fold of the previous step. The following diagrams describe this step in detail.

16. Valley-fold top edges down. Swivel-fold the middle of the top edge. See the next diagram.

19 Swivel the corner to the left on the valley fold of the previous step.

22. Valley-fold the legs to narrow them.

24. Turn the model over.

17. Lift up the top edge and redo the inside reverse-fold of steps 6 and 8 .

20. Valley-fold the top edge down. The head will swivel into place.

18. Valley-fold and unfold an angle bisector.

21. Turn the model over.


Optional: Create a "naughty or nice" santa with switchable faces. Put the santa over a tree branch or paste it on greeting cards.
